



Fate's Highway – Mini Synopsis

Rachel is young and beautiful, she has a certain innocence about her that comes from wanting for nothing most of her adult life. Rachel's glamorous lifestyle comes to a crashing halt when her country music star boyfriend kicks her out of their plush penthouse suite with no explanation, leaving her with nothing but a broken heart. Now with nothing left but her car and a suitcase, Rachel must go it alone and drive across the Nevada desert towards California.

While driving along a lonely stretch of desert highway Rachel takes her eyes off the road for a split second to use her cell phone. When she looks up she sees a man running across the highway. She slams the brakes but it's too late, her car plows into the man causing his body to violently tumble over the car landing with a thud in the middle of the road.

Rachel, terrified gets out of her car to check on the man's condition. It doesn't look good as she slowly approaches the man's body which is face down in a growing pool of blood. In a panic she calls her ex-boyfriends manager who tells Rachel to first get the man's body off the road and since there are no witnesses to get back in her car, drive away and never look back.
